Ian is currently employed by the NZ Business Excellence Foundation to run various awards programmes.

Ian grew up in Upper Hutt and attended Heretaunga College. He left the last year of

college early to seek gainful employment and spent that first year working in insurance before joining the Navy as an Engineering Apprentice in 1980. The first 4 years in the Navy were spent learning his trade and qualifying as a radio technician on land and at sea.

As an engineering officer Ian spent time in roles such as Deputy Fleet Maintenance Manager, Test Evaluation, and Quality Manager, Naval Science Projects Officer and the Director of Naval Information Systems. Ian finally left the Navy in 2005. For the last eight years of his Naval career, he became a key member and advocate in the implementation of the Navy’s continuous improvement programme called Naval Excellence and it was this association that led to Ian’s passion for continuous improvement and performance excellence. Ian continues to live in Auckland with his family and enjoys getting out on his Vespa as often as possible.
